

IMPORTANT NOTICE! Floor drain should extend at least 235 mm from the floor. Tube diameter 32 – 40 mm. Tube center distance from wall 50-60 mm.












Figure 2. Reinforced area (Plywood 20 mm with full thread screws) and external dimensions

1. Install the basin support arms and the operating interface










Install the cable tie mounts and route the controller wiring as pictured.
Leave a 140-150 mm loop of wire between the leg and basin support arm, this enables the unit to move.


2. Predrill all necessary holes. Refer to Fig. 1 for mounting hole positions. Install the top mounting screws into the wall.

NOTICE! If the wall material requires the use of a wall plug, silicone caulk should be used in the holes.



3. Lift the lifting unit on top of the top screws in the wall. Using a spirit level, ensure that the unit is installed level.




4. When the unit is level, tighten the top screws; insert and tighten the bottom screws. Plug the lifter to mains power and test it before adhering the basin.




IMPORTANT NOTICE! While testing, keep hands and tools away from the open mechanism. Before continuing work, unplug the unit.




5. Assemble the faucet, basin and plumbing







6. After testing the unit and cleaning the underside of the basin, adhere the lifting unit and install the plumbing.




13970 Water hoses, connectors and brackets package (sold separate) contains: 2 pcs. Hose L500 G1/2, 2 pcs. G1/2 10mm Cut-off valves and 2 pcs. Hose brackets





7. Install the bottom cover and tuck the excess mains wire. Attach the excess mains wire only to the bottom cover, not to the frame of the lifter.



8. Install the top cover and test the unit, water inlets and the drain.
