




Exploded view




3.4 Plug the unit to an outlet and test it by driving to the top and bottom positions.

IMPORTANT NOTICE! While testing, keep hands and tools away from the open mechanism. Before continuing work, unplug the unit.

















5.3 Install tha faucet. NOTICE! Cut the faucet tubes to a length of 150 mm.























































